HISTORY OF NEWPORT & CARDIFF

NEWPORT

ICC Wales lies on the outskirts of the bustling city of Newport with its new Friars Walk shopping centre, historic buildings and industrial heritage as a coal port.

Host city for the 2010 Ryder Cup and 2014 NATO Summit.

Even closer is the village of Caerleon, one of the most important military sites in Britain under the Roman Empire, and rumoured to be the home of Camelot, the fabled court of King Arthur.

Historic attractions include the Newport Medieval Ship, a 15th Century merchant vessel only unearthed in 2002, and the Transporter Bridge, one of only 10 such industrial crossings still operational in the world.

The home of incredible street food, Newport Market is bursting with food and drink stalls and a range of independent businesses selling a wealth of produce ranging from fresh farm goods to artisan confectionery.

Cardiff is a young, vibrant and dynamic capital city, where sparkling new shopping centres and state-of-the-art sporting stadiums mingle with Victorian arcades, a medieval castle and an historic civic centre.


